CANDIDACY REQUIREMENTS AND ELECTION PROCEDURES

- Date of Election: **Sunday, April 7, 2019**
- Officers Being Elected: Three Seats on the Board of Trustees
- Voter Eligibility: All King Farm residents who are eighteen years or over, have no financial delinquencies over 30 days, and are **registered** with the Assembly are qualified voters and may vote. All titleholders of houses, townhouse & condominium units, as shown on the Assembly's records, are automatically registered to vote. All other persons, including tenants and other occupants of a King Farm residence who are not the record owners of the residence, must complete a Citizen Registration Form in order to register as Citizens with the Assembly and to vote in Assembly elections.
- Voter registration forms can be picked up at the Assembly office or by downloading the Registration form from www.kingfarm.org.
- All registration forms are due by Wednesday, March 20, 2019 in order to participate in the 2019 Election.**
- Candidacy Eligibility: Any King Farm residents who are eighteen years or over, have no financial delinquencies over 30 days, and are **registered** with the Assembly may be a candidate for the election.
- Candidacy Deadline: Petitions for candidacy with valid signatures from King Farm residents along with a Statement of Purpose must be received by the Assembly office no later than **Monday, February 8, 2019**. Lack of the necessary number of valid signatures will result in an invalid candidacy petition.
- Statement of Purpose Mailing: The candidates Statement of Purpose will be mailed to the community on or about **February 25, 2019**.
- Mail-In Ballots: Mail-In Ballots with the Statement of Purpose will be mailed on or about **February 25, 2019**. All completed mail-in ballots must be postmarked or hand delivered to the Assembly office no later than **2 pm Sunday, April 7, 2019**. Any resident with outstanding fees or fines to the Assembly after March 7, 2019 will have their ballots rejected.
- Candidates Forum: A candidate's forum will be held on **Wednesday, March 13, 2019 at 7:30 pm** in the Saddle Ridge Community Building.
- Election Day and Annual Meeting of the Assembly: Election Day is Sunday, April 7, 2019. Polls will be opened at the Community Center from 10:00 AM through 2:00 PM. Beginning at 2:00 PM the Assembly will have its annual meeting during which time election winners will be announced and installed.
